As was shared, all K-8 students now have Google accounts. These accounts allow students to access digital resources and content in-school or remotely from home.

In the event the Garrison School is closed for an extended period of time, our teachers will be able to continue to deliver high-quality instruction via "Google Classroom", which is a virtual learning space. While many of our upper-elementary and middle school students already use this tool, all K-8 students now have the ability to use Google Classroom.

After your first time logging in, you may either login via www.google.com or classroom.google.com.
